OVERVIEW:

- Strong northwest winds tonight into Tuesday Morning.
- Below-zero wind chills expected for most of SNE, as low as 15 to 20 below in the Berkshires/northern Worcester Hills early Tuesday AM.

TIMING	 [Winds]: Increase early tonight, peaking overnight into late-AM Tuesday, diminishing Tuesday afternoon 	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	 Strong winds could produce minor tree and powerline damage. Possible power outages. 	
NWS ALERTS	 Wind Advisory: For all SNE late today into Tue AM. Wind Chill Advisory: For Berkshires and Worcester Hills from midnight to 10 AM Tue. Gale and Storm Warnings in effect for the coastal waters through Tue. Freezing Spray Advisory in effect from midnight through 1 PM Tue. 	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	 A few wind gusts to 60 mph possible across the higher terrain and the Cape/Islands tonight. 	
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	 A few snow showers/possible snow squalls tonight with brief period of low visibility around 10 PM - 2 AM Tue, especially N of Mass Pike. Daytime wind chills in the single digits and teens Tuesday afternoon.
