OVERVIEW:

- Strong northwest winds tonight into Saturday
- Wind Advisory issued for the entire region
- Confidence in strong winds is high, but the exact magnitude of the winds remains a bit uncertain.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Increasing tonight, peaking early Saturday morning▪ Strongest winds between 9 PM and 8 AM	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Wind gusts up to 45-55 mph. Isolated higher gust to 60 mph possible, especially in the Worcester Hills▪ Strong winds could produce minor tree and powerline damage. Power outages are possible.	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Wind Advisory in effect for all of southern New England▪ Gale Warning in effect for all waters	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ How widespread the highest wind gusts will be is uncertain.	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Winds will decrease below 35 mph by 7 am on Saturday but remain gusty (25-30 mph)▪ Strong wind gusts 35 to 45 mph return on Sunday.
