

Light Snow and Strong Winds



OVERVIEW:

- Rain changes to snow late Thursday night into early Friday morning.
- Light accumulation likely - minor impact to Friday AM commute.
- Strong NE winds gusting to 45-55 mph along coast & on waters.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Change to snow occurs 11 PM to 4 AM Friday northwest to southeast, then ends Friday morning.▪ Strong NE winds expected between 2 AM and 11 AM Friday.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Minor impact to the Friday morning commute. Some roads may have a slushy minor snow accumulation, especially secondary ones.▪ Strong winds & rough seas on coastal waters may hamper travel to the islands.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Gale Warning late Thursday night into Friday including Boston Harbor and Narragansett Bay.▪ Wind Advisories have been issued for Cape Cod, the islands & coastal Plymouth county.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Exact timing of changeover to snow and intensity of snow. Most likely scenario is 1-3 inches, although there is a low risk for 4 to 6 inches if the changeover occurs sooner along with heavier snow intensity. If these higher amounts materialize, some power outages would be possible. Although this is a low probability at the moment.
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Expect changes to snowfall totals as we better refine changeover timing.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Dry weather rapidly overspreads the area later Friday morning. NE winds diminish less than 35 mph by Fri afternoon.▪ Mostly sunny Saturday. Highs in 40s with light
