

# Strong Winds tonight-Mon



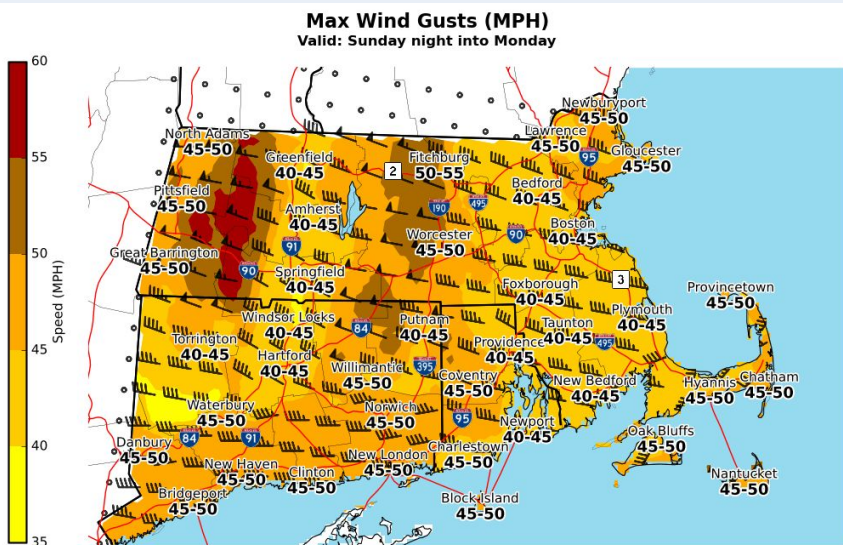

## OVERVIEW:

- Strong winds likely tonight into Monday. Expect northwest winds to gust 45 to 55 mph on Monday with low risk of 60 mph gusts.
- Wind Advisory issued for all areas tonight into Monday.
- Gale Warning in effect for all waters this afternoon into late Monday.

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Strongest winds Monday morning into early afternoon.</li><li>▪ Gusts gradually diminish late Monday.</li></ul>
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Widespread wind gusts of 45 to 55 mph Monday morning to early afternoon. Strongest winds most likely across the higher terrain of Worcester Hills and the Berkshires.</li><li>▪ Gusts diminish to 25 to 35 mph Monday late afternoon.</li><li>▪ Strong winds could produce minor tree and powerline damage.</li></ul>
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Low risk for 60 mph wind gust and uncertainty on areal extent.</li></ul>
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Warming trend with dry conditions Tuesday into Wednesday.</li><li>▪ Next chance for showers Wednesday night into Thursday.</li></ul>
