

WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Strong northwest winds Monday. Expect widespread gusts 45 to 55 mph, but scattered gusts up to 60 mph in western and central MA.
- High Wind Warning remains in effect for Western and Central MA. Wind Advisory elsewhere.
- Gale Warning remains in effect for all waters into Monday afternoon

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Strongest winds just after sunrise Monday morning into middayGusts gradually diminish Monday afternoon.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Gusts diminish to 25 to 35 mph Monday late afternoon, closer to sunset across the high terrain of MA.Some power outages likely especially the high terrain
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Areal coverage of 60 mph wind gusts.
