OVERVIEW:

- A long-duration storm will bring widespread heavy rain and high elevation snow late today into Friday

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Snow beginning this evening, ending late Friday eveningHeaviest snow expected overnight tonight into Friday, for locations mainly above 1000 ft in elevation.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">5-8 inches of snow in the Berkshires, with 10" possible above 1500 ft. 2-5 inches for the northern Worcester Hills, with 6"+ at elevations over 1000 ft. 2-5 inches parts of the CT River Valley.Snow will be heavy and wet resulting in possible downed tree limbs and power outages.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Winter Storm Warning for northern Berkshires 8 PM Thursday through Friday NightWinter Weather Advisory for the southern Berkshires, Connecticut River Valley in Massachusetts, and Worcester Hills 8 PM Thursday through Friday night
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Areal coverage and amount of accumulating snow, which will vary greatly with elevation.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Light precipitation lingers thru early Sat Morning.Dry on Sat with highs in the 40s and low 50s.
