OVERVIEW:

- Passing cold front will generate scattered thunderstorms Wednesday afternoon some of which may be strong to severe.
- Damaging winds, small hail, and an isolated tornado is possible.

TIMING	2PM - 8PM Wednesday Evening Greatest risk across western MA and CT west of I-395/I-190
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Damaging wind gusts are the most likely hazard▪ Large hail and an isolated tornado will be possible as well▪ Hazardous marine conditions also possible
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Some uncertainty in southeastern extent of strong to severe thunderstorm potential
Post Event Outlook	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Non-severe storms/showers linger into Wednesday night.▪ Clearing skies and drier conditions on Thursday
