

## **OVERVIEW:**

- Passing cold front will generate scattered thunderstorms Wednesday afternoon some of which may be strong to severe.
- Damaging winds, small hail, and an isolated tornado is possible.

TIMING	2PM - 8PM Wednesday Evening Greatest risk across western MA and CT west of I-395/1-190	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul> <li>Damaging wind gusts are the most likely hazard</li> <li>Large hail and an isolated tornado will be possible as well</li> <li>Hazardous marine conditions also possible</li> </ul>	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul> <li>Some uncertainty in southeastern extent of strong to severe thunderstorm potential</li> </ul>	
Post Event Outlook	<ul> <li>Non-severe storms/showers linger into Wednesday night.</li> <li>Clearing skies and drier conditions on Thursday</li> </ul>	
Severe Weather Outlook	SLGT	2 - SLIGHT (SLGT) Scattered severe storms possible Short-lived and/or not widespread, isolated intense storms possible
