## OVERVIEW:

- Passing cold front will generate scattered thunderstorms Wednesday afternoon some of which may be strong to severe.
- Damaging winds, small hail, and an isolated tornado is possible.

<b>TIMING</b>	5PM - 9PM Wednesday Evening Greatest risk across western MA and CT west of I-395/I-190
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Damaging wind gusts are the most likely hazard</li><li>▪ Large hail and an isolated tornado will be possible as well</li><li>▪ Hazardous marine conditions also possible</li></ul>
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Some uncertainty in southeastern extent of strong to severe thunderstorm potential</li></ul>
<b>Post Event Outlook</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Non-severe storms/showers linger into Wednesday night.</li><li>▪ Clearing skies and drier conditions on Thursday</li></ul>
