

- Passing cold front will generate scattered thunderstorms Wednesday afternoon some of which may be strong to severe.
- Damaging winds, small hail, and an isolated tornado is possible.

TIMING

5PM - 9PM Wednesday Evening
Greatest risk across western MA and CT west of I-395/1-190


HAZARDS &
IMPACTS

- Damaging wind gusts are the most likely hazard
- Large hail and an isolated tornado will be possible as well
- Hazardous marine conditions also possible

FORECAST CHALLENGES

- Some uncertainty in southeastern extent of strong to severe thunderstorm potential
- Post Event Outlook
- Non-severe storms/showers linger into Wednesday night.
- Clearing skies and drier conditions on Thursday
