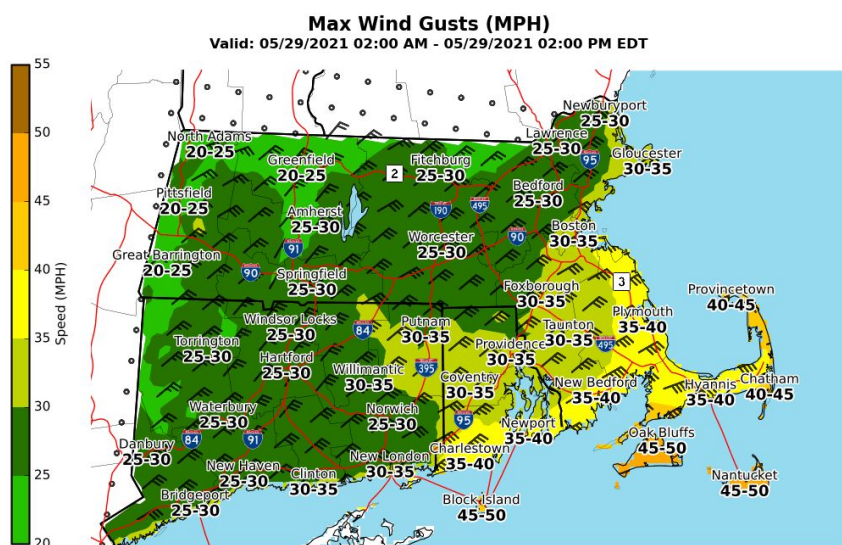




OVERVIEW:

- Widespread 1-2" of rain which may be heavy at times
- Wind gusts up to 50 MPH over The Islands may cause power outages
- Hazardous marine conditions and some splash over along east coastal locations also a possibility

TIMING	Heaviest Rainfall Friday night into late Saturday morning Strong Winds: 2 AM Saturday - 2 PM Saturday
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Sustained northeast winds 25-35 mph with gusts up to 50 mph ▪ Heavy rainfall at night ▪ Dangerous marine conditions ▪ Minor splash over possible along the eastern coastline ▪ Power outages possible
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Wind Advisory for Nantucket and Martha's Vineyard
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Some uncertainty with respect to minor coastal flooding ▪ Northward extent of heaviest rainfall
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Lingering showers Saturday afternoon to be followed by more substantial rain Sunday afternoon.
