



OVERVIEW:

- Widespread 1-2" of rain, locally higher amounts. Falling heavy at times
- Wind gusts up to 50 MPH over The Islands
- Splashover along east coastal Massachusetts
- Hazardous marine conditions

TIMING	Heaviest Rainfall: Overnight into late Sat AM Strong Winds: 2 AM Sat - 2 PM Sat Splashover/Minor Coastal Flooding: Around early Sat AM high tide (12 - 4 AM)	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Strong wind gusts may down tree limbs. ▪ Possible ponding or minor urban/poor drainage street flooding, associated with heavy rain. ▪ Splashover onto typically vulnerable eastern MA shoreline roads. 	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Wind Advisory for Nantucket and Martha's Vineyard. ▪ Coastal Flood Statement for the Eastern MA Coastline. ▪ Gale Warnings for most waters (except Boston Harbor/Narragansett Bay). 	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Some uncertainty with respect to minor coastal flooding. ▪ Northward extent of heaviest rainfall. ▪ Coverage of overnight urban/poor drainage flooding, if any materializes. 	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Rain tapers to intermittent showers Sat afternoon. ▪ Another significant rain event late Sunday into first half of Memorial Day.
