## Heaviest Rainfall: Overnight into late Sat AM Strong Winds: 2 AM Sat - 2 PM Sat TIMING Splashover/Minor Coastal Flooding: Around early Sat AM high tide (12 - 4

Strong wind gusts may down tree limbs. Possible ponding or minor urban/poor drainage street flooding, associated **HAZARDS & IMPACTS** with heavy rain. Spashover onto typically vulnerable eastern MA shoreline roads.

> Wind Advisory for Nantucket and Martha's Vineyard. Coastal Flood Statement for the Eastern MA Coastline. • Gale Warnings for most waters (except Boston Harbor/Narragansett Bay).

 Some uncertainty with respect to minor coastal flooding. Northward extent of heaviest rainfall. Coverage of overnight urban/poor drainage flooding, if any materializes.
