






# Heat Wave: Sunday to Tuesday

## OVERVIEW:

- Highs 90-95 each day with the hottest day likely Monday.
- Heat index (Apparent Temperature) values in the mid to upper 90s each afternoon

<b>TIMING</b>	▪ 90+ highs arrive Sunday afternoon, continuing through at least Tuesday.	
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Very hot temperatures with moderate humidity.</li><li>▪ Overnight lows remain very warm, not cooling below 70F in the urban centers</li><li>▪ Potential of heat related issues to at risk population and those doing higher levels of outdoor physical activities</li></ul>	
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	▪ None at the moment, but Heat Advisories may be needed.	
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	▪ Humidity levels may end up being higher than forecast, resulting in Heat Index values in excess of 100 F, especially Monday.
