## OVERVIEW:

- Highs 90-95 each day with the hottest days Sunday & Monday.
- Heat index (Apparent Temperature) values in the mid to upper 90s Sunday, Monday and likely into Tuesday.

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ 90+ highs from this afternoon through at least Tuesday.</li></ul>
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Very hot temperatures with moderate humidity.</li><li>▪ Overnight lows remain very warm, not cooling below 70F in the urban centers</li><li>▪ Potential of heat related issues to at risk population and those doing higher levels of outdoor physical activities</li></ul>
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Heat Advisories for Sunday and Monday, for consecutive days with heat indices (apparent temperatures) of 95-99. This includes the Greater Boston area, Metro West, the Merrimack Valley and the Greater Hartford/Springfield area.</li></ul>
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Duration of the heat wave, persisting into Wednesday?</li></ul>
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ The heat wave likely breaks Wed night</li><li>▪ Much cooler and less humid weather arrives Thursday &amp; especially Friday.</li></ul>
<b>NEXT BRIEFING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ By 5 pm Sunday</li></ul>

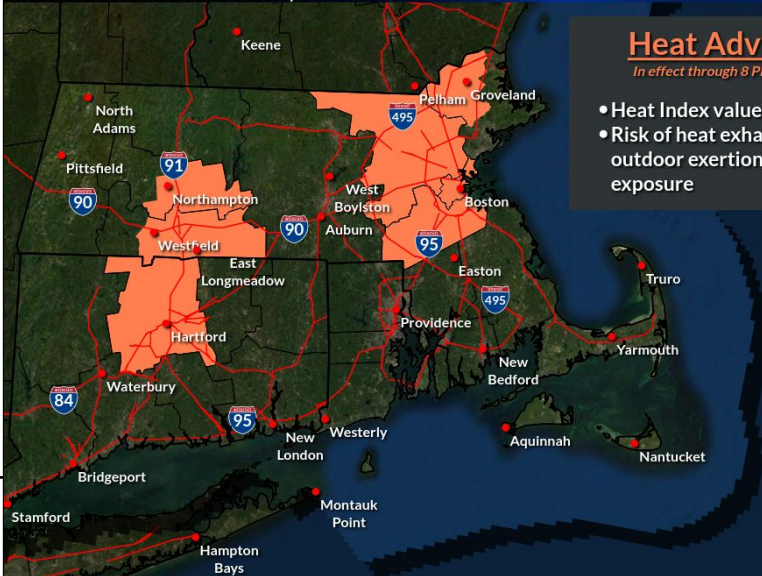
