


## OVERVIEW:

- Highs in the upper 80s to low 90s; Heat index (Apparent Temperature) values 95-97.
- Scattered afternoon thunderstorms: mainly heavy rain risk, but isolated strong/severe wind gust possible.

| TIMING              | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Heat Indices 95-97 degrees this afternoon.</li> <li>▪ Thunderstorms: As soon as early-afternoon, greatest coverage ~3-8 PM.</li> </ul>   |
| HAZARDS & IMPACTS   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Heat: Potential for heat related issues to at risk population and those doing higher levels of outdoor physical activities.</li> <li>▪ Thunderstorms: Heavy rain capable of localized street flooding; isolated/sporadic downed trees or powerlines.</li> </ul>  |
| NWS ALERTS          | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Heat Advisories today from noon till 8 PM for most except the Berkshires and the coastlines. Issued for consecutive days with heat indices of 95-100.</li> </ul>   |
| FORECAST CHALLENGES | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ [Heat] Still very warm and humid, but cloud cover may keep heat indices closer to the mid 90s.</li> <li>▪ [T-storms] Coverage of severe storms. Localized street flooding mainly in vulnerable areas: urban areas and/or locations that received excessive rains yesterday.</li> </ul>   |
