Potential Heatwave Next Week



OVERVIEW:

- Heatwave increasingly likely next week, with hottest days looking to be Monday and Tuesday.
- Heat Index/Apparent Temperature values 95-100F Monday & Tuesday and potentially into Wednesday.

TIMING

- 90F+ highs arrive Monday afternoon, continuing through Wednesday.
 - Some locations, especially those in the CT River Valley & Merrimack Valley may see 90F+ highs arrive on Sunday.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Days of oppressive heat and humidity.
- Overnight lows remain warm, likely staying above 70F in urban areas.
- Potential for heat related issues to at risk population and those doing higher levels of outdoor physical activities.

NWS ALERTS

None at the moment, but Heat Advisories may eventually be needed.
