

Oppressive Heat Continues



WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Oppressive heat continues, peaking on Tuesday.
- Heat Index/Apparent Temperature values 98-104F today through Wednesday with isolated 105-106F.
- Little nighttime relief, especially in urban population centers.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ 90F+ daily highs continue through Wednesday.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Prolonged period of oppressive heat and humidity.▪ Little nighttime relief with overnight lows staying above 70F, especially tonight and Tuesday night.▪ Potential for heat related issues to at-risk population and those doing higher levels of outdoor physical activities.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Heat Advisory expanded into the east slopes of the Berkshires and the immediate south coast, except for Cape Cod and the islands.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Some locations could see heat index values of 105F or higher on Tuesday and may be upgraded to an Excessive Heat Warning.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<div data-bbox="249 1236 428 1468"><ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Heat Wave breaks on Thursday/ Friday.</div> <div data-bbox="454 1124 1423 1860"></div>
