

# Oppressive Heat Continues

## OVERVIEW:

- Oppressive heat continues across Southern New England into Wed.
- Heat Index values 98-104F (isolated 105-107F) Tues, around 95-102F on Wed.
- Little nighttime relief, especially in urbanized areas.

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Highest heat indices expected Tues, a little lower but still oppressive into Wed.</li></ul>
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Prolonged period of oppressive daytime heat/humidity to those outdoors.</li><li>▪ Little nighttime relief with overnight lows staying above 70F tonight and Tuesday night.</li><li>▪ Potential for heat related issues to at-risk population and those doing higher levels of outdoor physical activities.</li></ul>
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Heat Advisories remain in effect through Wed except for Cape Cod and the Islands.</li></ul>
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Excessive Heat Warnings may be needed for parts of Southern New England Tuesday if the coverage of 105+F heat indices increases.</li></ul>
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<div><div><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Heat Wave breaks on Thursday/ Friday.</li></ul></div><div></div></div>
<b>NEXT BRIEFING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ By 6 AM Tuesday.</li></ul>
