OVERVIEW:

- Risk for scattered strong to severe thunderstorms this afternoon and evening

TIMING	▪ Greatest risk between 3 PM to 10 PM.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	▪ Damaging straight-line wind up to 60 mph is the greatest threat. Lower risk for small hail. Localized flooding possible, especially across the larger urban centers.	
NWS ALERTS	▪ Dense Fog Advisory until 10 AM for Rhode Island, as well as central and eastern Massachusetts	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	▪ How quickly and how much sunshine develops across southern New England. The more sunshine we receive, the more fuel we have for stronger storms this afternoon and evening.	
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	▪ Storms expected to weaken as they move east, especially after sunset	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	▪ Showers and thunderstorms expected to move offshore after midnight. Mostly dry Thursday with more summer-like conditons.
