WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- The Severe Prediction Center upgraded the severe threat for today/Tue from general to marginal risk.
- Scattered thunderstorms 6 pm to midnight across western Massachusetts with low risk of an isolated strong to severe thunderstorm

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ 6 pm to midnight.▪ Confined to western Massachusetts
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ An isolated storm or two may contain strong to damaging winds. This is NOT expected to be a widespread event.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Will all scattered storms remain sub-severe, or will there be isolated strong to severe storms.
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Dry, tranquil weather should prevail until about 6 pm, then a low risk for scattered thunderstorms from 6 pm to midnight across western MA.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Scattered thunderstorms are likely Wednesday, although storms will be more widespread & stronger Wed across eastern CT, RI and eastern MA.
