

## OVERVIEW:

- Isolated to scattered strong to severe thunderstorms are possible this evening.
- SPC has upgraded the risk for strong to severe thunderstorms across portions of southern New England

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Greatest risk remains 5 PM to midnight</li> </ul>
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Some storms may produce strong, potentially damaging, wind gusts up to 60 mph.</li> </ul>
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>How quickly storms weaken after sunset. Confidence has increased that stronger thunderstorms will survive farther east into southern New England.</li> </ul>
<b>ADDITIONAL INFORMATION</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Emergency Managers - please forward this message to DOT and DPW.</li> </ul>
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<p>Lingering showers possible Wednesday morning. Another round of showers and thunderstorms possible late Thursday.</p>
