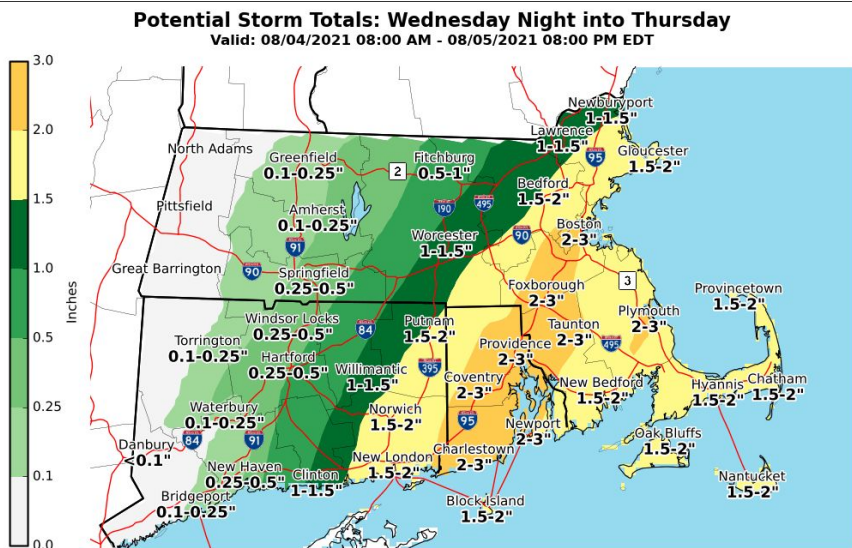
## OVERVIEW:

- Very heavy rain tonight into Thursday morning may lead to significant urban & small stream flooding issues
- Confidence is high in a swath of 1-3" of rainfall with localized amounts up to 4" possible. However, confidence is lower on the exact location of heaviest rainfall.
