

OVERVIEW:

- Highs low to mid 90s with Heat index (Apparent Temperature) values 98°F to 105°F away from the immediate coast.
- High confidence in a three day period (Wed-Fri) of oppressive heat

TIMING

Each afternoon of Wed. Thu & Fri. Heat Indices will be 98°F-105°F

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

 Potential for heat related issues to at risk population and those doing higher levels of outdoor physical activities.

Little relief at night especially in urban population centers.

NWS ALERTS

 No headlines at the moment but heat advisories or excessive heat warnings will likely be required.

• High dew points may limit how high actual temperature gets. Regardless, heat indices (combination of air temperature and dew points) are likely to be in the 98 to 105°F range.

 Afternoon showers/thunderstorms with associated cloud cover could also limit daytime high temperatures.
