

## **OVERVIEW:**

 The remnants of Fred may bring a period of heavy rainfall to the region Thursday. While the greatest risk of flooding will be to our west, localized flooding can not be ruled out in our region too.

TIMING	<ul> <li>Early Thursday morning through early Thursday evening.</li> </ul>	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul> <li>Greatest risk of flooding is west of our region. However, localized urban and small stream flooding can not be ruled out in our region. Greatest risk for our region would be in western Massachusetts.</li> </ul>	
NWS ALERTS	<ul> <li>None are currently in effect.</li> </ul>	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul> <li>Exact location of heaviest rainfall and flood potential. Greatest risk of flooding is west of our region, but there is a low risk in our region as well.</li> </ul>	
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul> <li>Greatest risk for 2 inches or more of rain will be in west and northwest Massachusetts.</li> </ul>
