What has changed: Tropical Storm Warning expanded to inland CT. Flood Watch in effect for western/central MA, RI, and CT. Hurricane Watch discontinued from Westport, MA to Sagamore Beach.


Disclaimer: The information contained within is time-sensitive. Do not use after 6:00 am EDT Saturday.

- Henri will make landfall near eastern Long Island
- Storm timing will be Sunday into early Monday, with heavy rain possibly lingering into Monday as Henri weakens rapidly over land.
- Threats include:
  - Inland flooding rains CT into western/central MA highest risk
  - Storm surge flooding and beach erosion along the south coast
  - Damaging winds east of the track RI westward

#### Tropical Storm Henri




**NOTE:** Do not focus on the exact track. Impacts can occur well outside the area enclosed by the cone.

- Hurricane Warnings in effect for coastal CT
- Tropical Storm Warning in effect for inland CT, coastal RI, and the south coast of MA to Martha's Vineyard
- Hurricane Watch in effect for RI coast
- Storm Surge Warning in effect for all of RI and southern MA coastline as far north as Chatham
- Cone represents historical error
  - Storm stays within cone 2/3 of time
  - Storm can track outside 1/3 of time

Tropical Storm Henri




 The earliest reasonable time of arrival of Tropical Storm Force Winds for southern New England is Saturday evening

**Tropical Storm Henri** 




 The most likely time of arrival of Tropical Storm Force Winds is Sunday morning



Tropical Storm Henri




- Storm Total rainfall forecast valid Sunday through Monday

#### Excessive Rainfall Outlook

 Areas outlined in red have the greatest potential for flash flooding Sunday/Sunday night



Confidence is high that the event will occur Sunday into Monday Confidence is moderate regarding impacts



Damaging winds possible, especially east of Henri's track and low risk of an isolated tornado



Surge flooding possible, especially along the south coast of RI



Rainfall flooding likely; more confidence on the heaviest rain in CT and western MA



Dangerous marine conditions – tropical storm or even hurricane-force winds and high seas.


