 Late Wednesday into Thursday TIMING

> • Widespread 2-4" of rain with isolated amounts up to 6" possible.

 Urban/poor drainage flooding and sharp rises on rivers and waterways; significant flooding possible. Road closures and washouts from excessive rain may impact the Thu AM commute. Possible strong t-storms Wed night & Thurs SE MA and southern RI; low prob of strong winds or brief tornado or two.

Flash Flood Watch in effect for ALL of CT, MA and RI Wednesday afternoon through Thursday afternoon.

• Increasing confidence in a narrow swath of significant heavy rains across CT/RI and SE MA, but may still shift north/east Coverage of strong storms near SE MA & southern RI late Wed nite into Thurs.
