

## OVERVIEW:

- Heavy rainfall ending early this morning
  - May result in a difficult morning commute especially across CT, RI and portions of eastern MA

### TIMING

- Heavy rain ends by 7-8 AM

### HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Additional amounts of 0.5 to 2 inches possible with the highest amounts over RI and SE MA.
- Road closures and washouts from excessive rain likely to impact the AM commute.
- Larger rivers will still be responding to the runoff.
- Power outages possible given fully leaved trees, saturated grounds, wind gusts up to 45 mph into eastern MA early this morning.

### NWS ALERTS

- Flash Flood Warnings in effect for much of southern New England.
- Wind Advisory for Cape Cod and E. MA Coast into this afternoon

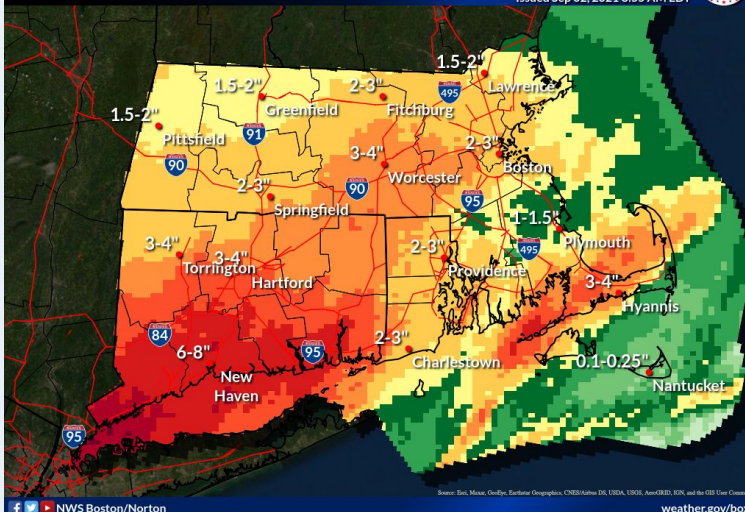
