



OVERVIEW:

- Isolated strong to severe thunderstorms moving through early this morning. Another round of showers/storms develop this afternoon & continue into the evening.
- Main threats are heavy downpours that may lead to localized flooding & damaging wind gusts

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Two rounds of thunderstorms, first round moves through this morning, then a second round possible this afternoon into the evening in RI and eastern MA.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Heavy rain may result in localized flooding, especially in urban areas Damaging wind gusts may bring some downed trees and limbs
FORECAST CHALLENGES	How potent the potential second round of storms will be this afternoon/evening
