

OVERVIEW:

- Two potential rounds of storms
 - Ist Late this afternoon into this evening (low confidence)
 - 2nd-This evening and overnight (high confidence)
- Main threats are damaging wind gusts and heavy downpours, which may lead to localized flooding.
- If the first round of storms develop then there would a risk of hail, damaging winds and a low risk of a tornado across western MA.

TIMING

- Ist potential round would be 4 to 8 PM
- 2nd round (main line) 10 PM to 6 AM

HAZARDS & IMPACTS


- Damaging wind gusts may bring some downed trees and limbs
 - Heavy rain may result in localized flooding, especially in urban and poor drainage areas
- Risk of hail and a low risk of a tornado if 1st round of storms develop

FORECAST CHALLENGES

If the 1st round of storms develop and how it impacts the line moving in later

Areal coverage and how late it extends overnight

POST-EVENT OUTLOOK • Dry and quiet weather for Monday and much of Tuesday. Near to slightly warmer than normal temperatures. • Strong/severe storms possible Wednesday into
