

# Severe Storms Possible Late Today

## OVERVIEW:

- Two potential rounds of storms
  - 1st - Late this afternoon into this evening (low confidence)
  - 2nd- This evening and overnight (high confidence)
- Main threats are damaging wind gusts and heavy downpours, which may lead to localized flooding.
- If the first round of storms develop then there would a risk of hail, damaging winds and a low risk of a tornado across western MA.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ 1st potential round would be 4 to 8 PM</li> <li>▪ 2nd round (main line) - 10 PM to 6 AM</li> </ul>
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Damaging wind gusts may bring some downed trees and limbs</li> <li>▪ Heavy rain may result in localized flooding, especially in urban and poor drainage areas</li> <li>▪ Risk of hail and a low risk of a tornado if 1st round of storms develop</li> </ul>
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<p>If the 1st round of storms develop and how it impacts the line moving in later</p> <p>Areal coverage and how late it extends overnight</p>
