- Greatest risk is across Northern/Western Massachusetts and Northwest Connecticut.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Damaging wind gusts may take down trees and limbs.</li> <li>▪ Heavy Rain may cause localized flooding, especially urban and poor drainage flooding.</li> <li>▪ Low probability of large hail/isolated tornado</li> </ul>
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ T-storm timing</li> <li>▪ Areal coverage</li> <li>▪ Intensity.</li> <li>▪ Strong storms reach RI and Eastern MA?</li> </ul>
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Unsettled. Chance of rain each day through Saturday.</li> <li>▪ Seasonable temps in the 70s to near 80.</li> </ul>
