

## **OVERVIEW:**

- Cold front will bring a chance for severe storms late today into tonight, moving in from eastern NY and southern VT.
- Greatest risk is across northern & western MA into northwestern CT.A more limited/lesser risk exists across remaining portions of CT, RI and MA.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul> <li>Damaging wind gusts may take down trees and limbs</li> <li>Heavy rain may result in localized flooding, especially in urban and poor drainage areas</li> <li>Low probability of large hail and an isolated tornado in strongest storms</li> </ul>	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul> <li>Thunderstorm timing</li> <li>Areal coverage &amp; intensity of evening storms: weakening trends likely as storms near the Hartford to Boston corridor, but a couple strong storms still possible?</li> </ul>
