



## OVERVIEW:

- Total rainfall of 1 to 2.5 inches, with locally higher amounts, is likely across much of southern New England this morning into Tuesday morning.

However, localized flooding is possible during periods of heavier rainfall, which could coincide with parts of this morning's and/or evening's commute.</li><li>▪ Potential for river flooding is also low, but some smaller streams could reach bankfull.</li><li>▪ Severe weather is not expected.</li></ul>
