OVERVIEW:

- Scattered showers and perhaps a few embedded thunderstorms are expected after 4 or 5 pm on Saturday.
- Brief heavy rain with wind gusts mainly in the 35-45 mph are possible.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Saturday between 4 pm and midnight.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Brief wind gusts of mainly 35-45 mph are possible with this activity. ▪ Low risk for an isolated severe thunderstorm, but nothing widespread. ▪ Isolated tree damage possible.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ None.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ If there will be embedded thunderstorms with the showers and how well the activity will hold together as it moves east out of New York State.
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ We are mainly expecting sub-severe wind gusts, but isolated tree damage is still possible given fully leafed trees.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Mainly dry and cooler on Sunday with highs in the 60s.
