- Scattered showers and perhaps a few embedded thunderstorms are expected after 4 or 5 pm on Saturday.
- Brief heavy rain with wind gusts mainly in the 35-45 mph are possible.

TIMING	▪ Saturday between 4 pm and midnight.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Brief wind gusts of mainly 35-45 mph are possible with this activity.▪ Low risk for an isolated severe thunderstorm, but nothing widespread.▪ Isolated tree damage possible.	
NWS ALERTS	▪ None.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ If there will be embedded thunderstorms with the showers and how well the activity will hold together as it moves east out of New York State.	
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ We are mainly expecting sub-severe wind gusts, but isolated tree damage is still possible given fully leafed trees.	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Mainly dry and cooler on Sunday with highs in the 60s.
