

Main Points

Hazard		Impacts	Location	Timing
Strong Winds		Tree and powerline damage with power outages. Greater tree damage potential given fully leafed trees & wet ground.	Worst of the wind impacts across eastern MA and Cape Cod and the Islands.	Strongest winds tonight into Wednesday morning. Easing Wednesday afternoon.
Heavy Rain		Difficult travel. Areas of urban and poor drainage street flooding. Rises on rivers and streams.	Heaviest rainfall shifting to eastern MA and Rhode Island tonight.	Heaviest rain this evening into early Wednesday morning.
Coastal Flooding		Minor coastal flooding on vulnerable shoreline roads. Up to 0.5 ft of inundation above ground level expected. Beach erosion.	Eastern MA coasts.	Wednesday morning and late afternoon high tides. <u>Beach erosion:</u> This afternoon into early Wednesday.





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


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
Additional Forecast Rainfall








Wind Related Hazards








Forecast Maximum Sustained Winds

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


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Forecast Maximum Wave Heights



Mariners

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- Peak gusts to storm force (55 to 65 kt) expected tonight into early Wednesday.
- Decreasing northeast gusts to gale force during Wednesday afternoon.
- Waves building to 15-25 ft over open waters, highest east to north of Cape Cod






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




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Coastal Flooding – Surge / Inundation

ΙΔΤΙΟΝΙΔΙ



Minor Coastal Flooding

- Partial inundation within the flood zone, especially for low-lying areas.
- Vulnerable shore roads with up to one half foot of inundation possible. May be flooding of a few vulnerable basements.
- Beach erosion with heavy surf tonight Wed.

Timing

Minor Coastal flooding for both early morning and afternoon high tides Wed.; beach erosion tonight – Wed night.

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		Storm Surge Threat	Potential Impacts from Storm Surge
	Little to None	0 to 1 feet above ground	No immediate preparations needed. Little to no potential storm surge flooding impacts
et	Elevated	1 to 3 feet above ground	To be safe, prepare for the potential of limited storm surge flooding impacts
el	Moderate	3 to 6 feet above ground	To be safe, earnestly prepare for the potential of significant storm surge flooding impacts
	High	6 to 9 feet above ground	To be safe, aggressively prepare for the potential of significant storm surge flooding impacts
	Extreme	> 9 feet above ground	To be safe, aggressively prepare for the potential of devastating to catastrophic storm surge flooding impacts
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Threat Event Summary

<u>Confidence</u>: High on winds; Moderate on rain & coastal flooding

Strong to damaging winds tonight into Wed. Power outages likely.



Heavy rain capable of minor urban/poor drainage flooding.



Minor coastal flooding for both high tides Wed; moderate to significant beach erosion.

All of Southern New England
