



OVERVIEW:

- Cluster of brief showers with embedded thunderstorms crosses the region late today. A few of these storms may be strong/severe
- Gusts of 40-50 mph & a few gusts up to 60 mph possible
- Very low but non-zero chance of a brief tornado

| HAZARDS & IMPACTS   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Strong wind gusts may down tree limbs &amp; bring power outages</li></ul>   |
| NWS ALERTS          | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Special Weather Statement highlighting the risk</li><li>▪ There is a low probability of a Severe Thunderstorm Watch being issued for parts of the area depending on how storms develop this afternoon.</li></ul>  |
| FORECAST CHALLENGES | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Uncertain the coverage of strong/severe storms and damaging wind gusts.</li></ul>   |
| POST-EVENT OUTLOOK  | <div data-bbox="242 1033 521 1651"><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Rain may briefly turn into snow above 1500 ft. Little to no accumulation.</li><li>▪ Gusts up to 40 mph continuing overnight, diminishing by morning hours.</li><li>▪ Overnight lows low to mid 30s.</li><li>▪ Drier weather returns Sunday.</li></ul></div> <div data-bbox="535 1014 1413 1671"></div> |
