- Potential for strong to damaging wind gusts Monday into Monday night.
- 40-60 mph southwest wind gusts possible.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Monday into Monday night.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Strong wind gusts may down tree limbs & bring power outages.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ None at this time, but wind headlines may be issued for Monday/Monday night by later shifts as confidence increases.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Uncertainty about the magnitude, timing and areal coverage of the damaging winds.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Dry, blustery and much colder on Tuesday. Highs in the upper 30s to near 40.▪ Potential for the season's first widespread accumulating snowfall across interior southern New England on Wednesday.
