- Strong to damaging southwest winds possible this afternoon and tonight.
- Wind gusts generally 40-50 mph, highest across SE MA, coastal RI, Cape Cod, Martha's Vineyard, Nantucket, and the Berkshires.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS	▪ Strong wind gusts may down tree limbs. Power outages possible.

FORECAST CHALLENGES	▪ Wind gusts are highly dependent on surface temperatures. Higher temperatures will promote higher winds gusts.	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Seasonable temperatures return Tuesday.▪ Potential for accumulating snowfall Wednesday into Thursday.
