



## OVERVIEW:

- First snow accumulation for much of the area expected Wednesday afternoon and evening
- Generally 1-2 inches of snow expected

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Wednesday afternoon and evening</li> </ul>
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>While snow accumulations will be minor, much of the snow will fall during the evening commute.</li> </ul>
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>None at this time, alerts may be considered if the forecast changes significantly</li> </ul>
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Forecast storm track and timing of the snowfall. A track further southeast will yield less snow, further northwest yields more snow.</li> <li>How quickly this storm moves out of our area.</li> </ul>
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Chilly and dry Thursday before a warming trend develops for the weekend.</li> <li>A few chances for low impact, light precipitation this weekend.</li> </ul>
<b>NEXT BRIEFING</b>	By 6 PM Tuesday
