


OVERVIEW:

- First snow accumulation for much of the area expected late today and tonight
- Generally a coating to 2 inches of snow expected

| TIMING | ▪ Most snow will fall between 6pm and midnight with lingering snow showers over eastern MA until 2-3 am. | |
| HAZARDS & IMPACTS | ▪ Minimal impact during the day with rain/snow showers. ▪ Best chance of accumulating snow after dark which may have some impact on the evening commute with some slippery roads ▪ High terrain west of I-495 is expected to see the highest accumulations | |
| NWS ALERTS | ▪ None at this time | |
| FORECAST CHALLENGES | ▪ How long will it take for snow to accumulate on paved surfaces | |
| POST-EVENT OUTLOOK | ▪ Chilly and dry Thursday ▪ Gusty winds and unseasonably mild Saturday into Saturday evening with showers and a few thunderstorms possible |  |
