

# Strong Winds Sat/Sat Night

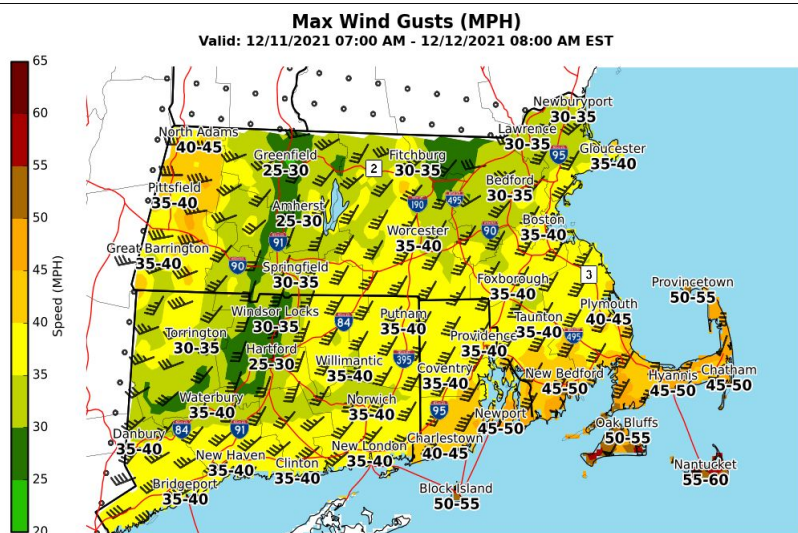

## OVERVIEW:

- 40-55 mph wind gusts possible Saturday into Saturday night as a frontal system moves through.

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Strongest south to southwest winds Saturday afternoon into early night</li><li>Strongest west to west-northwest winds late Saturday night.</li></ul>
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Wind gusts from 40-55 mph possible for Cape Cod, Islands, and South Coast</li><li>30-40 mph gusts possible across the interior.</li><li>Downed tree limbs, power outages possible.</li></ul>
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>None at this time; wind headlines could be needed in the next 24-36 hrs.</li></ul>
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Timing and strength of strong south winds.</li><li>Narrow band of gusty showers, low prob of thunder with cold front passage that could produce sporadic stronger gusts</li><li>Outside chance west winds behind front could produce minor wind damage.</li></ul>
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Cool/dry Sunday afternoon with gusty northwest winds (20-25 mph)</li><li>Quiet weather early next week</li></ul>
<b>NEXT BRIEFING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>By 6 AM Friday</li></ul>
