

WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- 40-55 mph wind gusts likely Saturday into Saturday night as a frontal system moves through.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Strongest south to southwest winds Saturday afternoon into early nightStrongest west to west-northwest winds late Saturday night.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Wind gusts from 40-55 mph for Cape Cod, Islands, and South Coast possible Saturday afternoon prior to the frontal passage40-55 mph gusts possible for all of southern New England late Saturday night as the cold front pushes through	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Gale Warning for the coastal waters from 7am Saturday - noon SundayWind headlines will likely be needed over land within the next 12-24 hrs.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Timing and strength of strong south winds.Narrow band of gusty showers, low prob of thunder with cold front passage that could produce sporadic stronger gusts to 60+ mph	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Cool/dry Sunday afternoon with gusty northwest winds (20-25 mph)Quiet weather early next week
