OVERVIEW:

 40-50 mph wind gusts expected Today and Tonight as a frontal system moves through southern New England.

TIMING

- Strongest south to southwest winds Sat afternoon into early night.
- Strongest west to west-northwest winds late Sat night into overnight.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Wind gusts from 40-50 mph for Cape Cod, Islands, and South Coast possible Sat afternoon prior to the frontal passage
 25. 45 mph gusts possible for all of southern New England leto Sat pic
- 35-45 mph gusts possible for all of southern New England late Sat night; strongest gusts likely in the Berkshires.

NWS ALERTS

- Gale Warning for the coastal waters from [7 AM Sat Noon Sun]
- Wind Advisory for all of southern New England [I PM Sat 5 AM Sun]


