## OVERVIEW:

- Confidence increasing for minor snow/icing Saturday and Saturday night
- Snowfall of 1-4 inches with the highest totals north of Route 2 in interior Massachusetts. Light icing possible inland (1/10 inch or less)
- Winter Weather Advisories may need to be issued sometime Friday

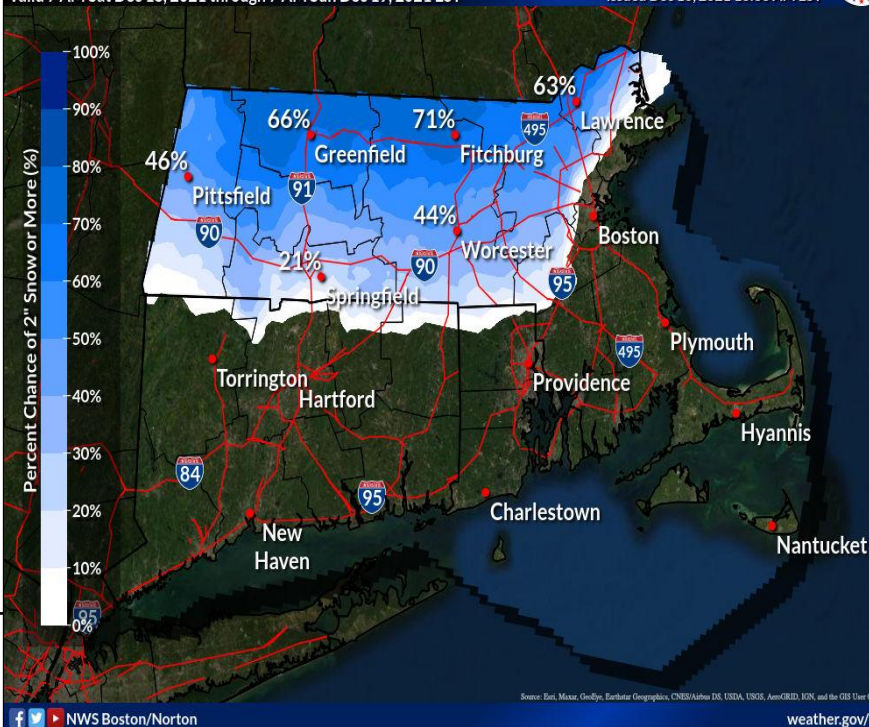
<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Snow/wintry mix inland starts Saturday morning. Mainly a cold rain for the coast, but a period of snow is possible at the onset</li><li>▪ Heaviest precipitation Saturday afternoon and night</li><li>▪ Tapers off by daybreak Sunday</li></ul>
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Hazardous travel possible, especially Saturday afternoon and Saturday night.</li></ul>
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ How quickly does the snow/wintry mix transitions to rain?</li><li>▪ Do areas near the VT/NH border stay all snow?</li></ul>
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Dry, blustery, and colder on Sunday with highs in the 30s and 40s.</li></ul>
<b>NEXT BRIEFING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ 5 AM Friday</li></ul>
