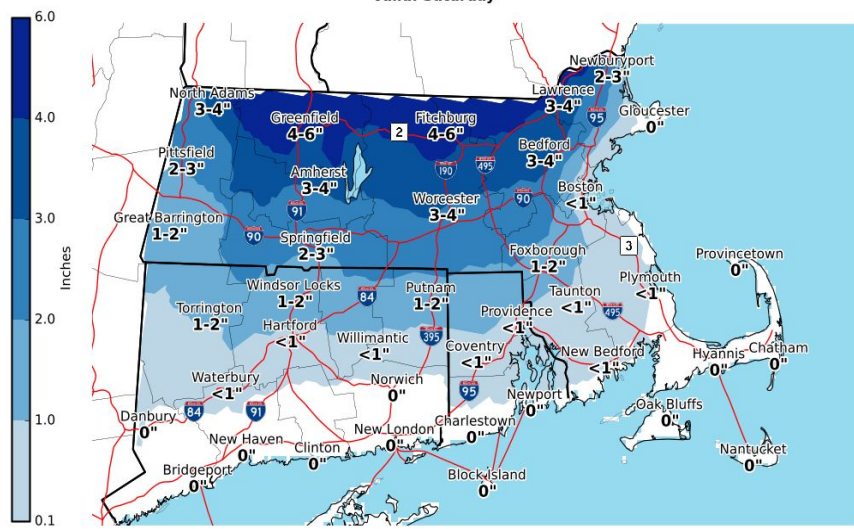
OVERVIEW:

- Confidence increasing in accumulating snowfall and/or ice on Saturday and Saturday night
- Snowfall accumulations of 1-5 inches with the greatest risk of the higher amounts north of Route 2 in interior Massachusetts
- Sleet/freezing rain with light ice accretion possible

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Snow/wintry mix for inland areas starts Saturday morning - mainly a cold rain for the coastal plain, but a period of snow is possible at the onset▪ Heaviest precipitation Saturday afternoon and night▪ Tapers off by daybreak Sunday
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Hazardous travel possible especially on any untreated roadways. Risk greatest Saturday afternoon and Saturday night.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ A colder solution would result in more snow than currently forecast▪ A warmer solution would yield in less snow, but more sleet/freezing rain
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Dry & blustery on Sunday with near to slightly cooler than seasonable temperatures
NEXT BRIEFING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ 5 PM Thursday
