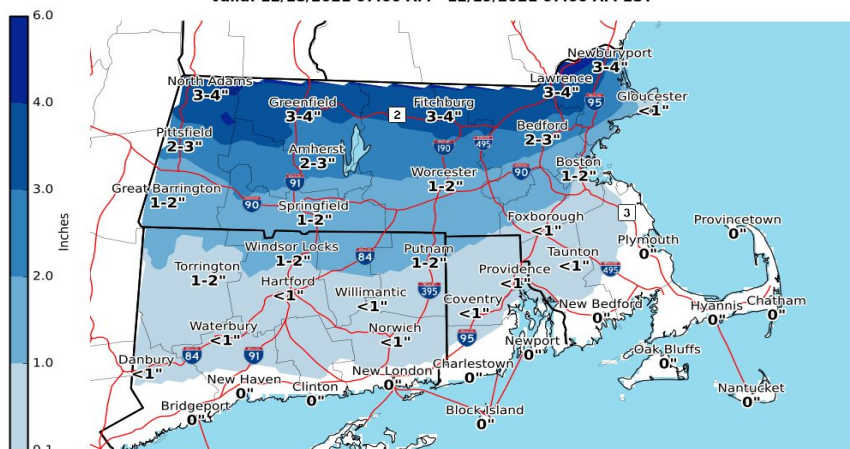
WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Wintry mix Saturday and Saturday night
- Snow and sleet accumulations of 1-4 inches with the highest totals north of Route 2 in interior Massachusetts
- Light glaze of ice across interior Connecticut and Massachusetts

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Snow/wintry mix starts Saturday morning into early afternoon. Quick changeover to rain closer to the coast. ▪ Heaviest precipitation Saturday afternoon and night ▪ Tapers off by daybreak Sunday
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Hazardous travel possible, especially Saturday afternoon and Saturday night.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Winter Weather Advisory for much of interior MA and northwest CT
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ How quick the transition from a wintry mix to rain takes ▪ Does the glaze of ice just form on only elevated structures, or does it form on roads? ▪ Duration in how long freezing rain/icing conditions last
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Dry, blustery, and colder on Sunday with highs in the 30s and 40s.
NEXT BRIEFING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ by 6AM Saturday
