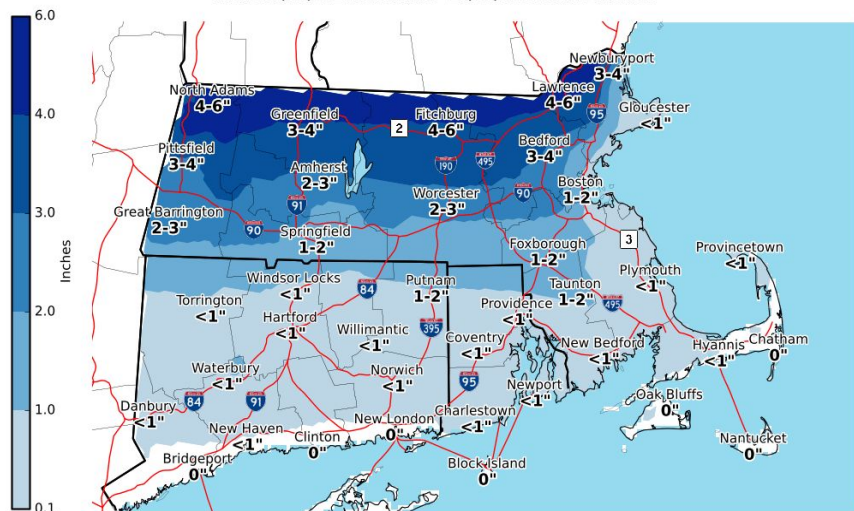


OVERVIEW:

- Accumulating snow and icing expected Saturday and Saturday night
- Snowfall of 1-5 inches with the highest totals north of Route 2 in interior Massachusetts. Light glaze of ice inland.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Snow/wintry mix inland starts Saturday morning into early afternoon. Mainly a cold rain for the coast, but a period of snow/sleet expected at the onset. ▪ Heaviest precipitation Saturday afternoon and night ▪ Tapers off by daybreak Sunday
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Hazardous travel possible, especially Saturday afternoon and Saturday night.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Winter Weather Advisory for much of interior MA
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ How quickly does the snow/wintry mix transition to rain? ▪ Do areas near the VT/NH border stay all snow? ▪ Advisory may need to be expanded into northern CT & northwest RI due to light freezing rain
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Dry, blustery, and colder on Sunday with highs in the 30s and 40s.
NEXT BRIEFING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ 5 PM Friday
