- Minor coastal flooding across eastern MA coastline due to high astronomical tides & waves

| NWS ALERTS | <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Winter Storm Watch Issued for Nantucket and Dukes Counties - Advisories or Warnings may be needed in future updates | |
| FORECAST CHALLENGES | <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Will heavy snow remain just offshore or track farther north across Cape Cod and the Islands? Trends have been north the past 24 hours, however the exact storm track remains uncertain. | |
